- Other Prohibited Items:

- o Electric scooters or hoverboards
- o Headboards
- o LED strip lights
- o Excessive wall coverings (including peel and stick wallpaper)
- o Extension cords and multi-plug adapters (surge protectors are allowed)
- o Lamps or halogen lamps with plastic shades
- o Power tools
- o Pets (except animals approved by the *Disability Resource Center or fish in 10-gallon tank, max. size)
- o Items used to loft beds
